Project Summary

ONEOK Partners built a parallel pipeline in Ellis County and Navarro County, Texas, starting southeast of Interstate Highway 35E west of Milford, Texas, and ending at ONEOK's Frost Pump Station in Navarro County, Texas.

QPSE prepared the construction packages which included, but were not limited to, site work for the launcher and receiver locations including access roads; hot tap support; fabrication drawings; installation of pig traps, including piping and valve work; ROW acquisition along with clearing and grading plans, trenching, and soil segregation; pipeline stringing, bending, line up, stringer bead, hot pass, fill and cap weld, coating, jeepping, and lowering; CP station cadwelding; padding and backfill; hydrotest and final tie-in. The environmental permitting was complete with SPCC, as well as ROW restoration.
